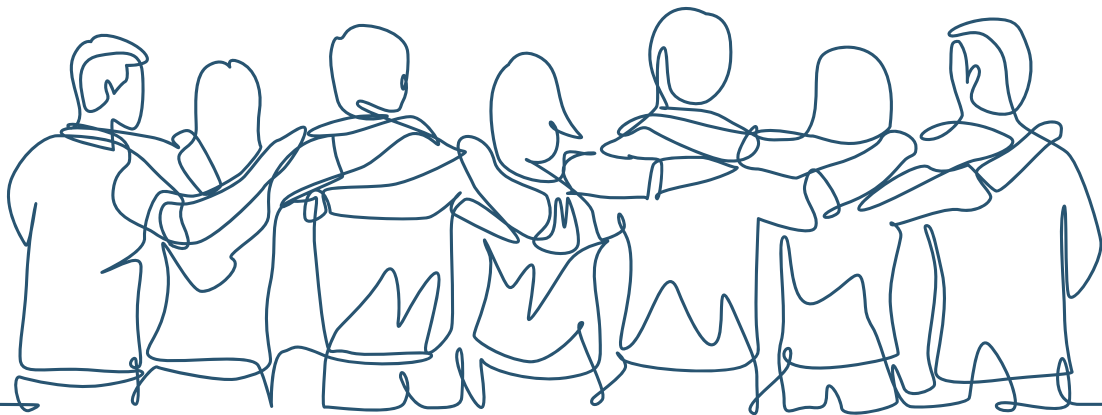

We continually seek to sow God’s love into the hearts and lives of people in our communities, developing new services that respond to the multiple needs affecting people today.

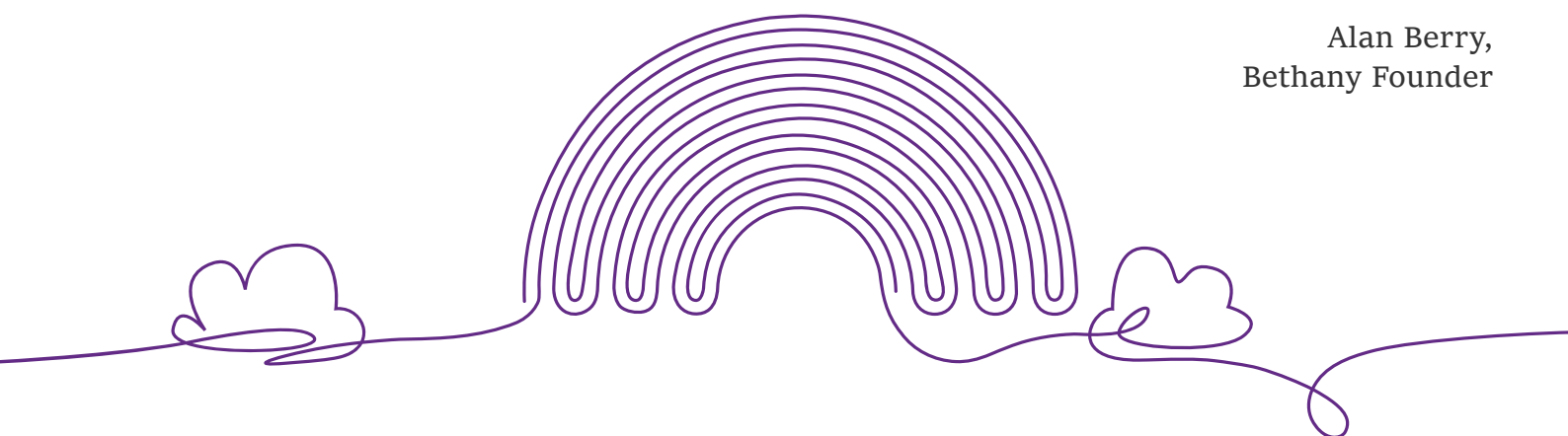


Dear Heavenly Father,

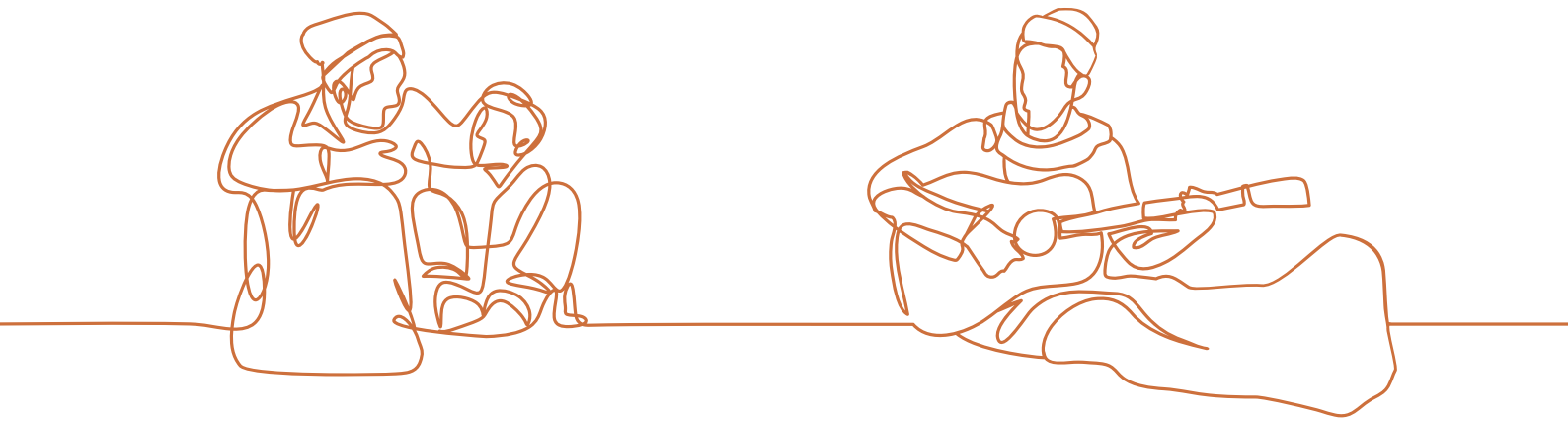
Dear God,

You alone can make Your people to be more like Your Son, so we ask You to be at work in every church, that new acts of generosity would begin, and well-established patterns of giving would be continued.

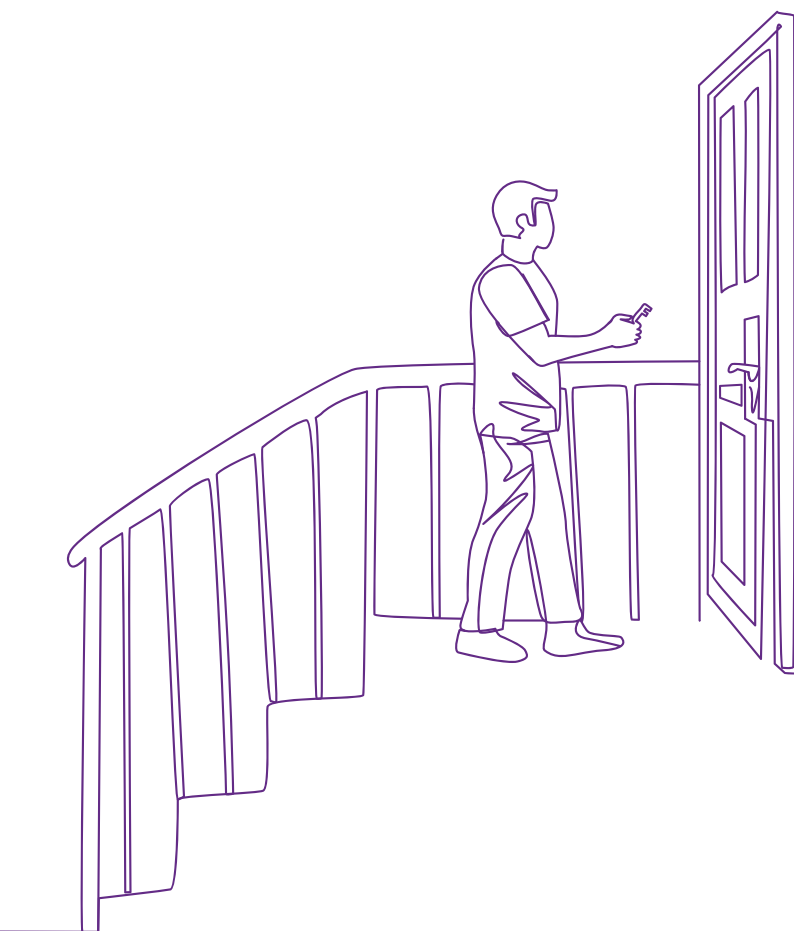
