# Welcome Centre

The Rapid Re-accommodation Welcome Centre is operated by Bethany Christian Trust and is open from

5 October 2022 to 3 May 2023.

It provides emergency shelter and support to move on to more suitable accommodation for anyone who would otherwise be sleeping rough. Three meals a day are provided.

It is located at the Haymarket Hub Hotel, 7 Clifton Terrace, Edinburgh EH12 5DR and can be accessed 24 hours a day. For more info or to check for spaces call 07919 557 673
