See what your gift could achieve:

£75

allows a child experiencing adversity to go on a weekend residential, potentially the only holiday that they will get that year. £600

pays for a week's stay for 4 different people at the Welcome Centre. This provides more than a bed and food, as people are assisted into secure accommodation.

£1,000

helps one person reintegrate into the community upon release from prison, with support in employability, housing and family reconciliation. £5,000

can be used to fund a community development project for a year. A gift of this size will help us extend our support into some of Scotland's most vulnerable communities. Regardless of the amount, your gift will have a lasting impact and will help us put an end to homelessness in Scotland.

After taking care of your friends and family, here are three ways to show your support for Bethany's work.



A share of your estate

This can be anything, from 1% to 100%. It's called a **Residuary gift**, and is a proportion of your estate once bills, legacies, expenses and taxes are deducted.



A sum of money

This amount can be whatever is suitable to your situation, and is known as a **Pecuniary gift**.



A specific item

These items could be jewellery, paintings, furniture, or anything else that can be sold to further Bethany's work.

- Family services




