Why should I leave a gift?

Whatever its size, your gift will ensure the continuation of life changing services and fund new projects to reach thousands of individuals across Scotland.

See what your gift could achieve:

£75

can allow a child experiencing adversity to go on a weekend residential, potentially the only holiday that they will get that year.

£700

could help to pay for a week's stay for 4 different people at the Welcome Centre. This provides more than a bed and food, as people are assisted into secure accommodation.



£1,000

could help one person reintegrate into the community upon release from prison, with support in employability, housing and family reconciliation.

£5,000

can be used to fund a community development project for a year. A gift of this size will help us extend our support into some of Scotland's most vulnerable communities.

Different types of Gifts in a Will



After taking care of your friends and family, here are three ways to show your support for Bethany's work.



A share of your estate

This can be anything, from 1% to 100%. It's called a **Residuary gift**, and is a proportion of your estate once bills, legacies, expenses and taxes are deducted.



A sum of money


This amount can be whatever is suitable to your situation, and is known as a **Pecuniary gift**.



A specific item

These items could be jewellery, paintings, furniture, or anything else that can be sold to further Bethany's work.

Keiko's Story

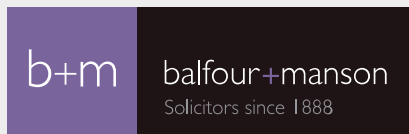

What about my family and friends?

We understand that looking after those closest to you is very important. Once you have, would you consider supporting people who are homeless or vulnerable to homelessness because they do not have family or a support network?

If I've left a gift in my Will, should I tell you?

We'd love to be able to use these pledges as the building blocks to Bethany's plans for our future services. They can be anonymous, but we would like to thank you for taking this generous step to supporting those who are homeless or are at risk of homelessness in Scotland today.

Can I give to a specific area of Bethany's work?

Projects can evolve and their names can change, especially over the course of many years, so we always advise that supporters donate to specific areas rather than services.

We want to enable you to support an area if it's close to your heart, and suggest phrasing your wishes as below:

I would like my gift to benefit:

- *Where it's needed most*
- *Emergency accommodation*
- *Addiction recovery*
- *Education and training*
- *Family services*

If you'd like to talk to us about where you would like to leave your donation, please don't hesitate to give us a call.

Can a gift to charity help me pay less tax?

In some cases, leaving a gift in your Will can reduce Inheritance Tax. We recommend you speak to a solicitor about your own specific situation.

I've sent in my pledge form. What happens if I change my mind?

Making a pledge is non-binding, it is your Will that directs how your finances will be distributed.

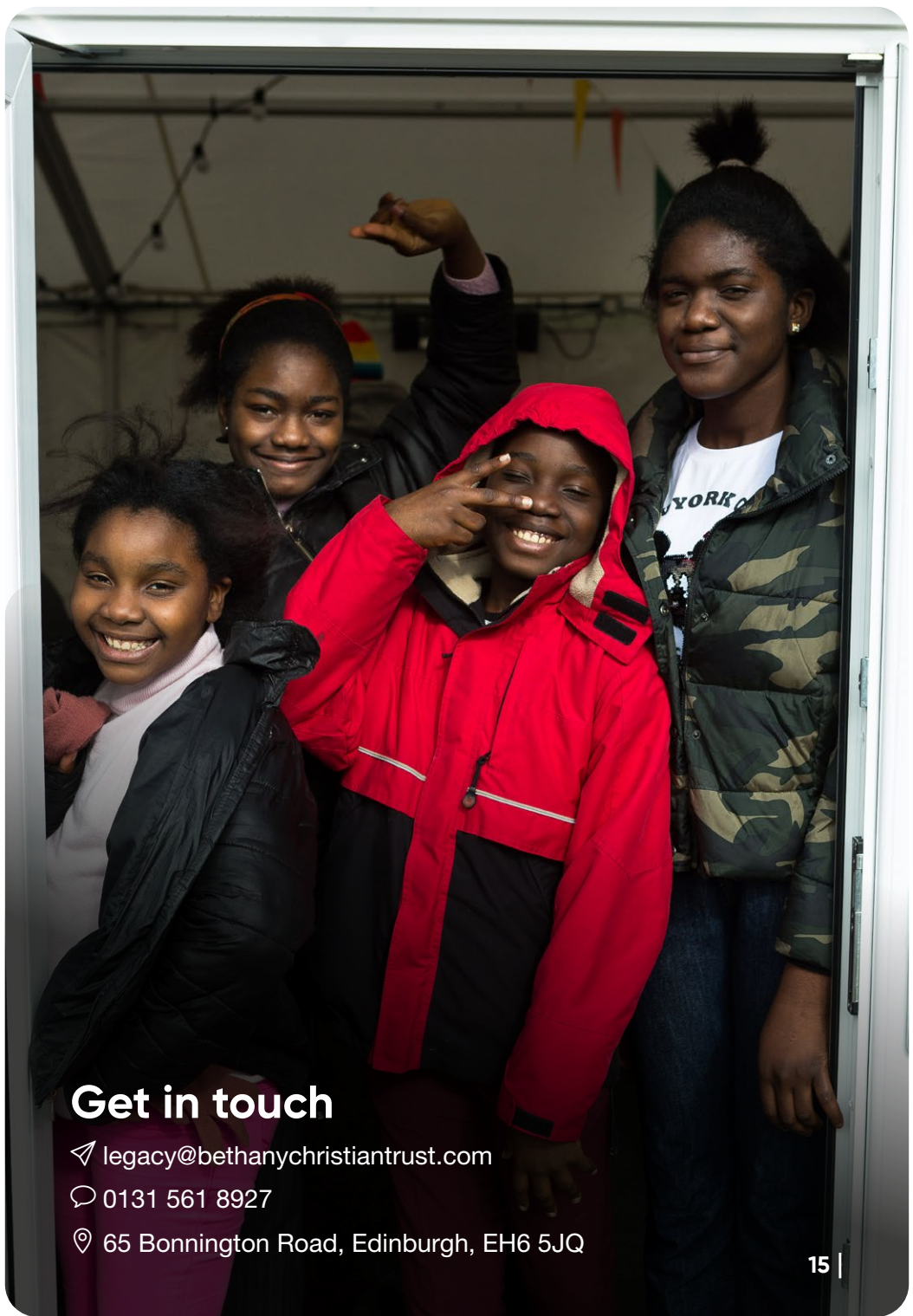
